How does the payment card work?

The payment card is like a debit card, and it allows you to easily access your health care funds. At many retailers, your eligible health care expenses will be auto-substantiated, reducing the need for you to submit receipts. You may still have to submit receipts for some of your purchases, so you will need to keep your receipts.

When do I get my payment card?

Your payment card will be mailed to your house during the transition period.

Do I need to do anything?
