



RETIREMENT PLAN ENROLLMENT

TIAA-CREF has made it easy for you to enroll in the Loyola University Maryland Retirement Plan by following these instructions. Do not hesitate to contact the Benefits & Wellness office at 410-617-1368.

BE READY WITH YOUR:

- Plan number "405950". The site may also refer to this as a "passcode" or "employer code"
- Investment choices and allocations. To view your options, go to <u>www.tiaa-cref.org/loyolamd</u>
 - One Decision Strategy Allocate 100% of your investment to the TIAA-CREF Lifecycle Fund closest to your estimated year of retirement

or

- Build Your Own Portfolio Strategy Indicate the percentage of your contribution you want allocated to each fund/account you choose
- Social Security number
- Beneficiary's Social Security number (optional), birth date and address

TO ENROLL:

- 1. Log in to <u>www.tiaa-cref.org/loyolamd</u> and click "ENROLL NOW"
 - Enroll online by selecting the "Retirement Plan" link or
 - Enroll by mail by following the on-screen directions to complete an enrollment application. Print the application and mail it to Loyola's Benefits & Wellness office. Do not return it to TIAA-CREF.
- 2. Complete a *Salary Reduction Agreement*. The Agreement can be found at

<u>http://www.loyola.edu/department/hr/forms.aspx</u>. Your enrollment in the retirement plan will <u>NOT</u> be completed until the Agreement is submitted to Loyola's Benefits & Wellness office. Send the required *Salary Reduction Agreement* to Maurisha Hooper by fax (410- 617-5072), email (<u>mhooper@loyola.edu</u>) or US Mail (Loyola University Maryland, c/o Maurisha Hooper, 4501 N Charles Street, Baltimore, MD 21210).

Remember to print your confirmation page from the "Thank You" screen after you've completed the enrollment.
