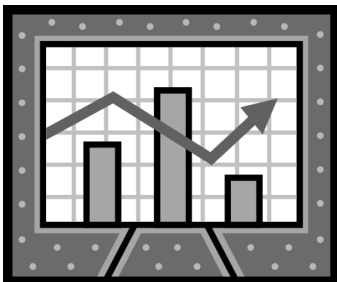

**DESCRIPTION**

This class follows the apprenticeship model: students will work along with professors on on-going research projects. Students will get their hands “dirty” working on qualitative or quantitative research projects. They may spend time in the library doing sophisticated database searches, and they may conduct fieldwork, interviewing informants. Students will learn how to use on-line survey research software: how to develop questionnaires, how to collect and analyze data, and they will learn how to write research reports. While this course is open to all students and there are no prerequisites, Seniors only, as there will be a significant amount of independent work.
