STUDENT HEALTH PROFILE INSTRUCTIONS

The Student Health Profile is required for **all full-time students** entering Loyola University. There are several parts to the profile that must be completed to be compliant with this requirement.

DEADLINE: JULY 1ST FOR FALL ENTRANCE | JANUARY 3RD FOR SPRING ENTRANCE

The Student Health Profile is to be completed online by visiting: www.Loyola.edu/PatientPortal

Please note: We recommend using Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome to complete the profile.

You will not be able to complete this profile until you are issued your Loyola University username and password If you have problems logging in, contact Tech Services at 410-617-5555.

Log in using your Loyola University issued username and password and complete each section of the Student Health Profile by following the steps listed below.

1. Under the FORMS tab:

- a. Student Health History
- b. Consent for Treatment

2. Under the UPLOAD tab:*

- a. Upload Immunization records/lab results for titers
- b. Upload photo of Insurance card (front & back)

3. Under the IMMUNIZATIONS tab:

a. Click on **"Enter Dates"** to enter the dates when you were issued the vaccines required by the university (*See page 2 for a list of required vaccinations*).

*Make sure you have uploaded a copy of your official immunization records from your doctor or titer bloodwork results through the "Upload" tab – Your vaccines cannot be verified by our staff without this step

4. Under the Insurance tab:

a. Go to <u>https://rcmdstudentbenefits.com/loyolauniversitymd/</u> to enroll or waive coverage in the Student Health Insurance Plan.

PLEASE NOTE:

- These health requirements are SEPARATE from any requirements for other programs such as Athletics or Sports Medicine. The information submitted is NOT shared between departments.
- Students with documented disabilities should register with Disability Support Services at (410) 617-2750 to ensure their specific academic, residential, and/or dining needs will be addressed during their time at Loyola. - Student Health Services will not contact you after you submit all the above information unless there is an issue, or you are missing a piece of your Student Health Profile.
