The ALANA Mentoring Program (AMP) pairs first year ALANA students with upper class students to assist them in acclimating to campus life at Loyola College. The ALANA Mentors play an integral role in working with students for the first year of their college experience. Mentors will help first-year students gain an understanding and appreciation of the College culture, introduce them to co-curricular activities and assist them with achieving academic and personal growth.

Qualifications:

- ★ Be a full-time undergraduate student at Loyola College, both currently and for the 2009-2010 academic year.
- ★ Be in good judicial standing
- ★ Participate in mandatory training during the fall and spring semesters.
- ★ Attend periodic meetings throughout the academic year.

Responsibilities:

- ★ Contact your mentees **every week**.
- ★ Participate with mentees in monthly programs sponsored by the ALANA Mentoring Program.
- ★ Assist mentees with academic growth.
- ★ Encourage mentees to participate in cultural programs sponsored on campus.
- ★ Be a team player willing to work with other mentors throughout the semester.
- ★ Serve as a liaison between your mentee(s) and the ALANA Services Office.
- ★ Commit to the mission and program objectives of the ALANA Mentoring Program.
- ★ Perform in the best interest of Loyola College, serving as a representative of the college by presenting a positive outlook and view of the overall program.
- ★ After receiving mentee, make initial contact during the summer.
