

***MOUNT SAINT AGNES/SISTERS OF MERCY SCHOLARSHIP AT
LOYOLA COLLEGE IN MARYLAND
For a Graduate Student for the 2008 – 2009 Academic Year***

The Mount Saint Agnes Alumnae Association invites eligible graduate students to apply for scholarship assistance.

ELIGIBILITY

In addition to completing the scholarship application form, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a direct descendant, niece, or nephew of a Mount Saint Agnes alumna (Relation must have successfully completed at least two years at Mount Saint Agnes College or Junior College.),
OR
Be a graduate of a Mercy affiliated high school.
2. Has been accepted and plans to enroll, or will continue enrollment in one of Loyola College's graduate programs for the 2008-09 academic year.
3. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.50

The scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis, taking into consideration the following categories:

1. Academic performance (based on Loyola's cumulative GPA)
2. Community service/activities

In case of a close competition added consideration will be given to a direct descendant of a Mount Saint Agnes alumna.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

A total of \$5,000 is available to award for the 2008-09 academic year.

RENEWAL

These scholarships are for a one-year period. They will not be automatically renewed for the following year. A student will have to reapply and demonstrate continued eligibility to be awarded an additional scholarship in subsequent academic years.
