And the winner: Loyola University Maryland Council 15000 in Baltimore.

Grand Knight Salvatore Lenzo said Council 15000 has already planned a program called Bridging the Digital Divide, which he describes as "working with small parishes in the Archdiocese of Baltimore and providing them with a means to communicate with their constituencies via social networking media such as Facebook."

The Knights are also working on how to include the parish documents into a digital repository.

Lenzo says council members plan to act as consultants to parish organizations to assist them with online communication.

Lenzo adds that the Knights are working with chaplain Father Tim Brown on installing the Catholic Daughters of America on campus as a sister organization.

Other current council activities include collecting funds to send Jesuits abroad for missionary and relief work; working with the Campus Ministry Office and Center for Community Service and Social Justice at a shelter for homeless people; and making monthly visits to the Veterans Affairs Rehabilitation Center, assisting Charles Carroll of Carrollton Assembly 375 with bingos.
