



DESCRIPTION OF SUPERVISORY ROLES M.S./C.A.S. & PH.D. LEVELS

CONSULTATIVE SUPERVISOR (M.S./C.A.S ONLY)

- Appointed by the Clinical Director when there is no licensed supervisor at clinical site. The C.S. is expected to meet with the student once a week for the entire semester - 15 hours - to replace the requirement for the site supervisors, or for a **minimum of 10 hours per semester**.
- There is no additional registration or fee connected with this procedure for students.
- Consultative Supervisors receive a stipend paid at the end of the semester for their supervisory sessions.

PRACTICUM SUPERVISORS - M.S. First Year Clinical Students Only

- All first year master's clinical students have a Practicum Supervisor appointed by the M.S./C.A.S. Director of Clinical Education.
- Practicum Supervisors are expected to meet a minimum of 10 times per semester with their supervisees.
- Ph.D. students registered for PC 952/953 Theory & Practice of Supervision are the primary source for Practicum Supervisors for the Fall/Spring semesters.
- When necessary, the Director has a list of licensed supervisors--faculty, Loyola Ph.D. graduates--who are available and willing to be Practicum Supervisors.
- No active Pastoral Counseling student may be a Practicum Supervisor, except while a student in the PC 952-953 class.

SUPERVISORY MENTOR (M.S./C.A.S. & PH.D. LEVELS)

- Appointed by the Clinical Director for the following situations:
 - student is a paid employee at placement
 - Clinical Committee determines that the student needs additional supervision
- Mentors are expected to meet with students once a week (15 times) per semester.
- M.S. / C.A.S. students register for 3 credit Mentoring Class PC 841, 842, 843, 844.
- Ph.D. students register for 3 credit Mentoring Class PC 941, 942. Doctoral level students need only register for Mentoring in their first year of doctoral clinical supervision.
- Mentors receive a stipend paid at the end of each semester.

INDIVIDUAL SUPERVISION - M.S./C.A.S. (PC 805-806); Ph.D. (PC 905-906)

- Students register for 3 credit Individual Supervision course for 2 semesters.
- With Clinical Director's approval, student selects a supervisor.
- Student meets with supervisor for 15 hours per semester following the therapeutic process with
 - a) just one client OR
 - b) several clients.
- Individual Supervisors receive stipend paid at the end of each semester.
