NOTE: All Presenters and Participants MUST REGISTER FOR THE CONFERENCE. Badges, Conference Program Guides, Bags and Entertainment Guide will be given to presenters onsite in the registration area.

Format for Proposals:

1. Type the title in CAPITAL LETTERS on the first line - skip a line.
2. Type the author(s) and primary affiliation(s) with affiliations placed in parentheses. Skip a line.
3. Type the Abstract:

If your submission is a **PAPER**, you will be assigned to a paper session where you will be presenting along with several other people who have related topics. Submit a 1,000 word abstract that includes the research question, methodology, results and interpretation along with any figures or tables. You will have approximately 15 minutes to make your talk.

If your submission is a **SYMPOSIUM** or **CONTENT SESSION** the amount of time you will be given will vary from 50 - 90 - 110 minutes. *Please indicate preferred time duration. Minimum of two presenters is required.* Submit a 300 word overall abstract plus a 300 word abstract for each presentation and name of presenter(s).

If your submission is a **POSTER**, you will be assigned to a poster session. Poster boards are approximately 6 feet long and 4 feet wide. You are expected to stay with your poster for the entire length of the session.

4. Type the following information for the primary author at the bottom of the last page:

Mailing address and phone number

Fax number and email address

Type of submission: Paper, Poster, Symposium

For Papers - indicate if the presenter author is willing to chair his/her paper session
