Loyola University Maryland has been approved for a cohort partnership with Baltimore County Public Schools to sponsor a Curriculum and Instruction (with Leadership Certificate) cohort. This program is designed for both classroom teachers and school administrators, in an innovative, inquiry-based program with a focus on social justice in the classroom. The Curriculum and Instruction program is designed to expose students to critical perspectives on reform in K-12 education and provides a strong emphasis on questions of equality. Beyond the core curriculum, students will specialize in Educational Leadership (Administration and Supervision). After successful completion students will receive the Master of Arts Degree in Curriculum and Instruction and eligible for Admin I endorsement.
