

Housing

Loyola offers air-conditioned housing in dormitory suites. The dormitory suites include a living room, kitchen, one bathroom, and two bedrooms. Some suites also include a dining room. Each bedroom includes two twin extra-long beds, two dressers, and two desks. The kitchen is furnished with a sink, refrigerator and stove (no microwave or cooking utensils).

These dormitory suites are used year-round. Please be prepared for a sparse, well-worn but clean space, intended to be a comfortable and functional study space: a quiet and calm environment meant to promote academic achievement.

Dormitory housing is independent living. The dorm-style housing does not provide the amenities of conference-style accommodations. Students are responsible for their own cleaning, laundry, and general room maintenance.

Students may request either single occupancy (one person to a bedroom--limited number available) or double occupancy (two people to a bedroom). The rates are \$56.00 per night for single occupancy and \$51.00 per night for double occupancy. **We will work to accommodate requests for type of room and/or roommate; however, Loyola reserves the right to make assignments based on space availability. Please be advised that room assignments are final and cannot be changed.**

The following is provided as part of your housing:

- three towel sets (set includes one bath towel, one wash cloth)
- three sets of linens (set includes two sheets, one pillow case). Mattresses are plastic covered; some students choose to bring an extra mattress pad.
- two blankets, two pillows (many students prefer to bring their own pillow)
- soap, tissues, and toilet tissue
- access to coin operated laundry facilities (\$.1.25 a load to wash and \$1.00 to dry)
- parking available in the residence area only (parking is extremely limited on the Academic Quadrangle; there is a hourly pay lot adjacent to the academic area)
- telephones in rooms; long distance calls by credit card or collect only
- kitchens are furnished with stove, sink, and refrigerator. **Please Note: dishes, utensils, pots, pans, etc. are not furnished. All cooking utensils and accessories must be supplied by the student.**

Check-in for students using campus housing will be **Tuesday, June 18**, from 2pm–9 pm. **Checkout** is 11:30 am – 1 pm and 4 pm – 5:30 pm on Friday, July 12, or 8 am – 10 am on Saturday, July 13. **[Please note that classes will run throughout the day on July 12. We advise that you not schedule airline departures prior to early evening on July 12.]**

If you are reserving housing, please indicate on the form the day you will be checking out.
