  - Amount Awarded: up to \$1000
  - Requirements: Applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in a Department of Psychology at the graduate level.
    - ✓ A complete application consists of electronic versions of the following materials:
    - ✓ One completed cover sheet.
    - ✓ One copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae (CV)
    - ✓ One copy of the project description (please omit identifying information)
    - ✓ One letter from the applicant's faculty supervisor addressing the quality and feasibility of the project, and qualifications of the applicant
  - Deadline: February 1st

  - Description: SME, in appreciation and recognition of the advancement and understanding of Manufacturing Engineering and Technology through the FIRST Robotics Competition and FIRST Tech Challenge, has established an endowed scholarship with the SME Education Foundation. This endowed scholarship is known as the SME Education Foundation – FIRST Scholarship. T
  - Amount Awarded: \$1,600 non-renewable at accredited school of your choice
  - Requirements: Manufacturing Engineering, Manufacturing Technology, or a closely related program
  - Deadline: February of each year

  - Description: The Islamic Society of North America (ISNA) in conjunction with HRH Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal announces the Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal ISNA Fellowship Program. This Fellowship is being offered to Muslim Americans pursuing graduate studies in the management and governance of non-profit organizations in the United States.
  - Amount Awarded: cover up to \$11,000 per year for tuition and required fees
  - Requirements: Muslim graduate students pursuing a degree in non-profit management, philanthropy or other related fields are eligible for the fellowship. In addition applicants must have:

- **Description:** The Aziz Jamaluddin ISNA Scholarship Program was established because of the strong belief in the need of Muslim students pursuing journalism. Mr. Jamaluddin noted the long history of biased media reporting and felt that there has been a lack of voices representative of Islam inside mainstream media. His continuing dedication and focus on helping the needy and promoting education and training of future leaders, serves as the inspiration for this scholarship. The primary goal is to have a generation of educated Muslims to speak out and communicate the true meaning of Islam in all types of media. This program is administered by ISNA and is funded by the Jamaluddin family.

- **Requirements:**
  - ✓ GPA of 3.5 or higher
  - ✓ Demonstrated financial need
  - ✓ A Journalism or Political Science Major (B.S. or M.S.) at a US accredited institution
  - ✓ American Citizenship or Permanent Residency
- **Deadline:** Rolling
