<a href="#">Aziz Jamaluddin Scholarship Program</a>	Description: The Aziz Jamaluddin ISNA Scholarship Program was established because of the strong belief in the need of Muslim students pursuing journalism. Mr. Jamaluddin noted the long history of biased media reporting and felt that there has been a lack of voices representative of Islam inside mainstream media. His continuing dedication and focus on helping the needy and promoting education and training of future leaders, serves as the inspiration for this scholarship. The primary goal is to have a generation of educated Muslims to speak out and communicate the true meaning of Islam in all types of media. This program is administered by ISNA and is funded by the Jamaluddin family. Scholarship awards are used for tuition, room and board or textbook costs at post-secondary educational institutions, or for other technical training programs approved by the Scholarship Committee. Preference will be given to applicants who are members of the SBE; however, any individuals otherwise eligible, including graduating high school seniors, are encouraged to apply. This support will cover expenses beyond what the youth is entitled to in federal/state and other scholarship assistance and is designed to assist the youth in obtaining a baccalaureate degree without suffering from substantial debt. To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must demonstrate financial need and provide a verification letter from a physician or transplant coordinator.
