

Scholarships for African-American/ Black Students

- [Reynelda Muse Journalism Scholarship](#)
 - Description: The Colorado Association of Black Journalists (CABJ) is now accepting applications for its Journalism Scholarships.
 - Amount Awarded: \$1,000-2,500
 - Requirements: Outstanding African American journalism students from Colorado high schools and colleges; Qualified students may have a grade point average of 3.0 or above
 - Deadline: Rolling
- [CBC Spouses Heineken USA Performing Arts Scholarship](#)
 - Description: The CBC Spouses Heineken USA Performing Arts Scholarship was established in 2000. This highly competitive scholarship was developed in honor of the late performing artist Curtis Mayfield and provides financial assistance to students pursuing performing arts careers. Each year, scholarships are awarded to gifted and talented students who want to pursue careers in music, drama and other arts vocations.
 - Amount Awarded: Up to \$3,000 each for up to 10 students.
 - Requirements: minimum 2.5 GPA; Be a full-time undergraduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university OR a current high school senior preparing to become a full-time undergraduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university; pursuing a career in *performance arts*
 - Deadline: May 1st
- [CBC Spouses Visual Arts Scholarship](#)
 - Description: The CBC Spouses Visual Arts Scholarship was established in 2006. This program provides financial awards to students who have a passion for and plan on pursuing a career in the visual arts.
 - Amount Awarded: Up to \$3,000 each for up to 10 students.
 - Requirements: minimum 2.5 GPA; Be a full-time undergraduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university OR a current high school senior preparing to become a full-time undergraduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university; pursuing a career in *visual arts*
 - Deadline: May 1st
- [CBC Spouses Education Scholarship](#)
 - Description: The CBC Spouses Education Scholarship is our general scholarship and is also our largest. This scholarship does not have a specific major requirement, and is open to full-time students of all academic fields.
 - Amount Awarded: varies
 - Requirements: Be a full-time undergraduate or graduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university OR a current high school senior preparing to become a full-time undergraduate or graduate degree-seeking student at an accredited college or university; Have a minimum 2.5 GPA; Exhibit leadership ability and participate in community service activities
 - Deadline: June 5th

- [CBCF Environmental Studies Scholarship](#)
 - Description: The CBCF Environmental Studies Scholarship seeks to provide financial awards to college students pursuing a degree in environmental science or other related fields, particularly minorities and women.
 - Amount Awarded: \$5,000 each to two (2) students
 - Requirements: CBCF will award 2 scholarships to full-time undergraduate students who are rising juniors or seniors enrolled at an accredited four-year college or university
 - Deadline: July 3rd
- [Foreign Language and Area Studies Fellowship](#)
 - Description: The Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowships program provides allocations of academic year and summer fellowships to institutions of higher education or consortia of institutions of higher education to assist meritorious undergraduate students and graduate students undergoing training in modern foreign languages and related area or international studies. Eligible students apply for fellowships directly to an institution that has received an allocation of fellowships from the U.S. Department of Education.
 - Amount Awarded: The estimated institutional payment fellowship is \$18,000 for a graduate student and \$10,000 for an undergraduate student. The estimated institutional payment for a summer 2015 fellowship is \$5,000 for graduate and undergraduate students. The estimated subsistence allowance fellowship is \$15,000 for a graduate student and \$5,000 for an undergraduate student. The subsistence allowance for a summer 2015 fellowship is \$2,500 for graduate and undergraduate students.
 - Requirements: Institutions conduct competitions to select eligible undergraduate students and graduate students to receive fellowships, in accordance with FLAS program eligibility requirements and the institutions' FLAS selection procedures.
 - Deadline: Rolling
