- Description: ISF's goal is to encourage Muslim students to pursue a college or post-graduate degrees in humanities, social sciences, liberal arts and law.
- Amount Awarded: \$1000-\$10,000
- Requirements:
 - ✓ Be Muslim
 - ✓ Citizen or permanent resident of United States
 - ✓ Minimum of 3.4 grade point average
 - ✓ College Junior standing or above
 - ✓ Active member of his or her community
- Deadline: April 15th of each calendar year.

- Description: In an effort to highlight the academic and civic achievements of young Muslim women in the DC Metropolitan Area, *S.I.S.T.E.R.S* initiated this scholarship program in 2007. This year, three one thousand dollar scholarships will be awarded: One to a high school senior, one to a college student and one to a graduate student.
- Amount Awarded:
- Requirements:
 - ✓ Be a Muslim female between the ages of 17-24 years old (for high school and college only; no age limit for graduate student).
 - ✓ Currently be enrolled in or accepted to a 2 or 4 year college.
 - ✓ Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.5 or better.
 - ✓ Demonstrate an active participation in community service work.
 - ✓ Submit a grade transcript.
 - ✓ Complete a short essay component.
 - ✓ Submit a letter of recommendation.
- Deadline: March of each year

- [Aziz Jamaluddin Scholarship Program](#)

- Description: The Aziz Jamaluddin ISNA Scholarship Program was established because of the strong belief in the need of Muslim students pursuing journalism. Mr. Jamaluddin noted the long history of biased media reporting and felt that there has been a lack of voices representative of Islam inside mainstream media. His continuing dedication and focus on helping the needy and promoting education and training of future leaders, serves as the inspiration for this scholarship. The primary goal is to have a generation of educated Muslims to speak out and communicate the true

meaning of Islam in all types of media. This program is administered by ISNA and is funded by the Jamaluddin family.

- Amount Awarded: (10) \$4,000
- Requirements:
 - ✓ GPA of 3.5 or higher
 - ✓ Demonstrated financial need
 - ✓ A Journalism or Political Science Major (B.S. or M.S.) at a US accredited institution
 - ✓ American Citizenship or Permanent Residency
- Deadline: Rolling
- [HRH Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal ISNA Fellowship Program](#)
 - Description: The Islamic Society of North America (ISNA) in conjunction with HRH Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal announces the Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal ISNA Fellowship Program. This Fellowship is being offered to Muslim Americans pursuing graduate studies in the management and governance of non-profit organizations in the United States.
 - Amount Awarded: cover up to \$11,000 per year for tuition and required fees
 - Requirements:
 - ✓ Muslim graduate students pursuing a degree in non-profit management, philanthropy or other related fields are eligible for the fellowship. In addition applicants must have:
 - ✓ Graduated from a college or university (with a BA/BS or graduate degree) within one year of application deadline, or be currently enrolled as a graduate student
 - ✓ Completed all admissions and GRE testing requirements for application to academic program
 - ✓ U.S. citizenship or legal permanent residency
 - ✓ Ability to complete an internship with a U.S. non-profit organization, (consisting of a minimum of 480 hours).
 - ✓ Availability to attend an intensive five-day orientation and training program as well as to assist with work at the ISNA Annual Convention. (ISNA covers all expenses related to travel, hotel and other accommodations necessary for attendance at orientation and the convention.)
 - Deadline: February 01, Annually
