

Good Stuff Campaign 2012 Student Worker Application

The Center for Community Service & Justice sponsors student workers to help with the Good Stuff Campaign during Senior Week. These student worker positions provide support to the campus-wide effort to collect food and other lightly used items for local community agencies. Students are given contract extensions for their campus housing. Each student worker should be available to work 8 hours during regular business hours from Monday through Friday (May 14-18) and for at least 7 hours on Saturday, May 19 (Graduation Day).

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assist with collecting and sorting donated items from across campus.
- 2. Help deliver collected items to local agencies (including driving).
- 3. Help coordinate the collection of items at various campus stations on Graduation Day.
- 4. Help organize and lead other student volunteers.
- 5. Assist with advertising and distributing promotional materials for the Campaign.
- 6. Abide by the Code of Student Conduct at all times during the period of employment.
- 7. Other duties as assigned!

QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED: Courteous and hospitable attitude with fellow volunteers and community partner guests; good verbal communication skills; promptness and reliability; flexibility and resourcefulness; interest in sustainability and campus recycling; sense of humor.
