Welcome to Loyola!

All international exchange students who attend Loyola University Maryland must show proof of several immunizations, as specified by the University's Student Health and Education Services. These immunizations are required to ensure all students meet guidelines set out by the American College Health Association and the Centers for Disease Control. All students residing in University dormitories or apartments must prove that they have met these requirements to be granted eligibility to live in university housing.

To record these immunizations, Loyola University Maryland's Student Health and Education Services require the completion of the attached **Immunization and Health History** Form by your Physician. You are required to submit your completed form to the Office of International Programs prior to your arrival at Loyola.

Below are the pre-entrance Health Immunization Requirements, as stipulated by Student Health and Education Services, which you must have prior to your arrival at Loyola. If you are unable to arrange for these immunizations or to provide proof of prior immunization by this time, you will be required to receive the immunizations on campus for the fees specified below.

Vaccine	Loyola Health Services Fee
Tetanus-Diphtheria	\$50.00
<i>Polio</i>	--NOT OFFERED AT LOYOLA--
Measles, Mumps, Rubella	\$75/each, two doses required
Tuberculin Test (PPD)	\$20
Meningococcal Vaccine	\$130
Hepatitis B Vaccine	\$75/each, three doses required
<i>Varicella (Chickenpox)</i>	--NOT OFFERED AT LOYOLA--

***NOTES: These fees are subject to yearly increase.
