This sheet may not include all charges associated with study abroad due to factors beyond Loyola's control (host institution changes, inflation and fluctuating rates.

## Charges Billed by Loyola for Loyola Programs:

- ➤ Loyola Tuition (\$21,345 per semester Fall 14-Spring 15)
- Financial Aid on Loyola programs:

All Loyola financial aid, with the exception of Federal College Works Study, can be used to assist with educational expenses. It is the student's responsibility to contact Loyola's Financial Aid Office to ascertain how his/her aid will work.

- Program Fee: \$550 (in Fall 2014 and Spring 2015)
- Reduced Comprehensive Fee (\$130 in Fall 2014 and Spring 2015)
- Programs Billed Incidental Charges due to the following items but not limited to: withdrawing from program, loss and/or damage of property abroad, missed trips and events sponsored by the program, cleaning bills assessed to Loyola

## Items/Costs Associated with Studying Abroad:

- Housing: paid in Paris (estimate: \$900 to \$1600 per month per person; most often \$1200 monthly—see Comforts of Paris/Comforts of Home)
- ❖ Health support/coverage fee: 43 euros in the Fall 2014 (paid to AUP)
- ♦ Housing insurance: Paid in Paris (40 euros in the Fall 2014)
- ❖ Travel insurance (Students can arrange on their own if they wish to purchase coverage for travel cancellation, belongings, etc.)
- ❖ Tuition/cancellation insurance (Students can arrange on their own if they wish to purchase coverage for travel cancellation, belongings, etc.)
- Documents:

Passport – (must be valid for 6 months after the end of your program abroad)

<u>Immigration File Fee</u> – Campus France USA fee to pay to Campus France USA (\$100 fee -- Money Order only)

Student Visa fee (\$68 in 2014 can be paid with a credit card)

Official Transcript (\$5 in Spring 2014)

<u>Photos</u> (for via application and study abroad documents) 2 passport format (\$5), 4 I.D. format (\$5)

Pre-paid envelope (USPS, overnight and self-addressed)

- Meals
- ❖ Airline ticket: NOT covered by the program (estimate: \$1600 Fall 2104)
- ❖ Medical Insurance: (<u>Required</u> -- if your current plan covers you abroad for emergencies only you will be required to purchase AUP's health insurance (435 euros in the Fall 2014) or a supplemental health insurance approved by AUP).
- Books and Supplies (estimate \$350)
- Onsite public transportation: monthly Navigo card in Paris (unless you decide to walk and buy individual tickets as needed)
- Transportation to Departing and Returning Airport City
- Official Pick-Up from Airport to Program Site: AUP will pick you up at the Paris airport at no additional cost if you arrive on the day and at the times they will indicate.
- ❖ Official Pick-Up from Program Site to Airport: Not included in this program
- \* Rentals: (bedding, bicycles, kitchen utensils, etc.,)
- On-site optional services (house cleaning, laundry, etc.)
- Personal Expenses: (personal travel, communication costs, entertainment, etc.,) Average (estimate): (\$3500 to \$6000 per semester, depending on independent travel, shopping, etc.)
- Incidental charges: (emergencies, charges assessed by the host institution)
