Faculty Coverage Report Undergraduate School of Education Courses

Introduction

Throughout the academic year, the Office of Institutional Research produces a series reports evaluating faculty coverage of course sections. This report contains data on the distribution of undergraduate credit hours taught in the School of Education by (1) full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty, (2) full-time non-tenured or clinical faculty, (3) part-time faculty with 4/5 or 1/2 contracts, and (4) per-course faculty. The data are disaggregated by department.

Methodology

Data for this report were drawn from Census Course and Human Resource files. These data files, among many other files, form the basis of the University's records used in federal and state reporting.

In order for the Faculty Coverage Reports to be comparable year-to-year and across departments, some courses are excluded from the analysis. Specifically, courses with less than five enrollments, independent studies, student research, individually-arranged internships, externships, private music lessons, music ensembles, non-credit courses, thesis/dissertation credits, service-learning, Modern Studies, Military Science, courses taught by personnel designated as "Staff," and FE 100 courses are excluded from the Report's tabulations. In addition, average section size calculations exclude student teaching-internships, graduate practicum, and supervision courses. Faculty are classified by academic department according to Human Resources records.

After taking the above inclusion and exclusion criteria into consideration, a number of statistics are calculated to describe faculty coverage of courses. The total number of faculty teaching course sections, the number of sections taught, the average section size, and the student credit hours generated are tabulated in total and disaggregated by faculty type and department.
