With the help of the REPUBLIC WASTE SERVICES, Loyola sends a large portion of our waste stream to recycling every week. They collect and process our recyclables which diverts waste from the landfill.

WHAT DO THE RECYCLING BINS MEAN?

**RECYCLING:** Any plastic marked #1-7, glass, plastic and metal drink containers, plastic food containers, juice and milk containers, clean paper.

COMPOST: Napkins, boxes, utensils, econtainers, greenware cups, and food waste.

TRASH: Styrofoam, paper towels, plastic bags, non-compostable utensils, chip bags, plastic coated paper such as coffee cups.
