

# Psy.D. Clinical Externship Site Information

**Name of Site:** PsychCare Psychological Services, LLC

**Location of Site:** Baltimore, Columbia, or Silver Spring, Maryland

**Population/Specialty:** Moderate-High Functioning Adults / Multi-Specialty (due to the 24 current associates, many of whom have their own specialty e.g. domestic violence, addictions, psycho-educational testing, etc.) Supervisors include a wide array of psychologists that have backgrounds in specialty training, ranging from psychologists specializing in cognitive-behavioral therapy to psychologists with advanced post-doc training in psychodynamic theory.

**Primary Externship (Clinical) Activities** (i.e., individual therapy, assessment, group therapy):

Individual therapy, couple therapy, group therapy and psychological assessment.

**Application Requirements** (i.e., letters of recommendation, deadlines, etc...):

Application Requirements: (1) Current enrollment in a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical or Counseling Psychology Program (APA-Accredited, preferred); (2) Completion of at least one course in psychology assessment and the write-up of at least 2 (two) full batteries, one of which is an adult; (3) Affirmation of Eligibility from the Director of Clinical Training at the student's home university to participate in the Psychology Externship Program (4) Malpractice coverage.

Application deadline is March 1<sup>st</sup>. Offers for interviews will be granted on a rolling basis, and positions will be filled by the end of March. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply early.

**Externship Requirements/Experiences** (i.e., days required, dates of inclusion, didactics, psych associate status): 15-20 hrs/week and some evening hours are required. Externship starts in September and continues through May. Psych Associate status is required.

**Type/names of assessments used:**

WAIS-IV, WISC-V, WASI-II, Shipley-2, MMPI-2, PAI, Rorschach, TAT, BDI-II, BAI, BAARS, STAXI, STAI, etc

**Type and frequency of supervision** (i.e., individual, group, weekly):

Externs receive supervision by licensed clinical psychologists with the following frequency and type:

Weekly: Individual / Therapy / 1 hour face-to-face

Small Group / Psychological Assessment / 1 hour face-to-face

Bi Weekly: Psychological Assessment / Large Group – 1 hour face-to-face

Bi Weekly: Therapy / Large Group / 1 hour face-to-face

Note: The above times/frequency is the typical duration of supervision. Supervision time will vary based on the skill level and needs of the extern, as well as requirements of the various doctoral programs.\_
