<p>Maryland Coalition Against Sexual Assault (MCASA) https://mcasa.org/who-we-are/jobs-internships</p>	<p>Our mission is to help prevent sexual assault, advocate for accessible, compassionate care for survivors of sexual violence, and work to hold offenders accountable. MCASA actively works to end sexual violence in the State of Maryland through professional training, public outreach, public policy advocacy, technical assistance, and legal services.</p> <p>Through hands-on learning responsibilities, MCASA’s program interns are engaged in the important effort to end rape, child sexual abuse, and the full continuum of sexual violence including campus sexual assault and human sex trafficking. They are exposed to the latest thinking in the field of sexual assault prevention and response through webinars and trainings, professional meetings, and written resource materials. Program interns also come away with practical knowledge about a statewide nonprofit organization’s strategies for office management, internal and external communications, professional training, and public outreach.</p> <p>To apply, send a cover letter, resume, and one writing sample to interns@mcasa.org. Applications are accepted at any time. The start date is flexible; we require a minimum commitment of three months at 15 hours per week.</p>
<p>State’s Attorney’s Office, Baltimore City https://www.stattorney.org/careers-training</p>	<p>The Office of the State’s Attorney for Baltimore City is responsible for the prosecution of all crimes that occur in Baltimore City. Uncompromisingly committed to accountability, professionalism, and transparency, the BCSAO works towards a future where community trust in the criminal justice system is restored, violent offenders are held accountable, and communities feel safe. We seek to cultivate an environment where success is measured not solely by the number of convictions obtained but how we engage communities and apply justice independent of one’s sex, race, religion, sexual orientation, or occupation.</p> <p>Justice is the only barometer of success for our office, which is why our prosecutors are sworn to aggressively pursue “justice over convictions” in</p>

	<p>every case. Justice is doing what is fair and appropriate in each case, taking into account the nature of the crime, its impact upon the victim, and the circumstances of the defendant. Sometimes justice requires a conviction and lengthy prison sentence, but other times justice requires dropping all charges, or diverting a defendant out of the criminal justice system into drug rehabilitation, education, or job training.</p> <p>The Undergraduate Internship Program is designed to cultivate the interest of undergraduate students in the role of a prosecutor in Baltimore City, and for the BCSAO to create a pipeline for prospective employees. Students can expect to be assigned to one unit for the duration of their internship. However, in rare instances, the needs of the office may require a student to split time between two units.</p> <p>Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. <p>Adelante Familia (at House of Ruth) https://hruth.org/get-help/adelante-familia/</p>	<p>Adelante Familia, a bilingual program at the House of Ruth Maryland, is dedicated to the eradication of intimate partner violence in the Latino community. Adelante Familia serves Spanish-speaking immigrants living in Baltimore who are victims, or are at risk of being victims, or are perpetrators of intimate partner violence.</p> <p>Adelante Familia is the only comprehensive intimate partner violence program in Maryland providing specialized intimate partner violence intervention services for Spanish-speaking immigrants. We are a women-centered advocacy model with a focus on providing comprehensive, linguistically and culturally-specific services as they pertain to case management (one on one support), individual and group counseling, education, and advocacy. Because of the specific needs and realities that Spanish-speaking victims face, Adelante Familia has always provided full services, regardless of whether or not the woman chooses to stay in the relationship. Our job is to provide a thoughtful engagement with each individual in the family to promote the family's ability to be resilient and move boldly forward.</p>

	<p>The Family Crisis Center accepts applications for internships from students pursuing studies in counseling, social work, and other human services professions. The Center offers a broad range of direct practice experience in case management, counseling, groups, and community outreach. Interns have opportunities across programs to develop knowledge and skills in intake and assessment, crisis intervention (phone and face-to-face), advocacy, risk assessment and safety planning, goal planning, resource management, and evaluation of progress/outcomes.</p> <p>The Center expects students to have an interest in intimate partner violence and family systems. Students must have effective communication skills, self-awareness, and commitment to professional development and ethical reasoning. Students can expect to receive regular individual and group supervision, initial orientation and ongoing learning opportunities, and access to on-site task supervisors.</p> <p>Contact (410) 285-4357 and talk to our intern coordinator for more information.
