Faculty Fellow Seminar

If you're interested in learning more about community-engaged teaching, consider signing up for CCSJ's Faculty Fellows Seminar in Service-Learning. The seminar will meet 5 times over the course of the Spring semester. You'll work with a small cohort of faculty from across the university to learn the foundations of community-engaged pedagogy and to design your own service-learning course.

Fellows who complete the seminar will:

- ❖ Be authorized to teach courses which are officially designated as service-learning. These the student enrollment in these sections will be **capped at 80%** of a normal section.
- ❖ Have the support of a **mentor**, a designated Loyola faculty member who is experienced in community-engaged pedagogy.
- ❖ Meet with **Loyola's community partners** and develop a connection which will fit the Fellow's service-learning course.
