Warning about Spain's current state of emergency: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Spanish government declared a national state of emergency **from October 27th until May 2021**. Loyola will make a final decision about summer programs in February 2021.

- ❖ Cultural and linguistic immersion experience, ideal for freshmen, sophomores and juniors
- ❖ Housing in pairs with Spanish host families in downtown Granada
- ❖ Loyola-approved courses taught at the University of Granada's *Centro de Lenguas Modernas*
- ❖ Includes visits to Madrid, Toledo, Sevilla and Costa del Sol, as well as tours and cultural activities around Granada
- ❖ Accompanied by Loyola program director
- ❖ All activities listed are tentative for our 2021 as they may depend on travel restrictions inside Spain at the time of the program.

SN 104 and SN 201

ML 111 - Immersion Research Project (for all program participants)

PROGRAM FEE: \$ 3,850 (airfare not included)

Program fee includes: tuition, room and board with Spanish host families (3 meals per day, laundry once per week), a variety of group excursions and activities, airport transfers and on-site group transportation.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY:

- ✓ Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- ✓ No history of serious disciplinary problems
- ✓ Completed prerequisite (SN103 or SN104) courses by May 2021 or proof of direct placement in SN 104 or SN 201
