Paris trip: May 18 to 30, online class until June 6, 2020.

(Cost \$3,850. Includes: tuition, housing, one free weekend, breakfast and one meal a day, all group and guided visits – Airfare not included)

Instructors: Dr. André Pierre Colombat Department of Modern Languages and Literatures; Office of International programs

Travel with Dr. Colombat an exploration of the rich past and present of Paris examining how a major city creates a sense of place while facing some key contemporary issues.

- Required Pre-course orientation meetings
- Course includes **Eleven-day trip to Paris, France, May 18-30, 2020**, plus on-line follow up sessions until June 6, 2020,
- Cost: tuition and Paris trip (including breakfasts every day, one free weekend, 2 lunches and 1 dinner, lodging (11 nights), subway, activities and visits included)
- **Three-credit course** fulfills requirements for Area Studies (International Business), Global Studies, Modern Languages Majors and Minors, Modern Language ML course requirements, Diversity requirement



- **This course is entirely taught in English. No language component—prior French not required.**
- Minimum required GPA 2.5.
- **Applications due and \$500 deposit due:** February 12, 2020 (first come first served)
- **Minimum enrollment: 10 participants**
