LOYOLA RECYCLES

A guide to single stream recycling in the residence halls



Mixed paper, glossy paper, envelopes, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, cardboard, and paperboard boxes. Staples and inserts do not need to be removed.



Plastic containers marked numbers #1 through #7, including plastic drinking cups, milk jugs, peanut butter jars, margarine tubs, yogurt containers, and prescription bottles. Lids and caps do not need to be removed.

GLASS & METALS

Metal food and beverage cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice cartons, clean aluminum foil, disposable aluminum pans, and aerosol cans.

NOT ACCEPTED

Paper towels, napkins, soiled paper, pizza boxes, plastic bags, styrofoam, hot coffee cups, waxy paper, chip bags, candy wrappers, unmarked plastic, and food waste.

Recycling dumpsters are located outside of every residence hall.

Please use **GREEN** dumpsters for recycling Please use **GREY** dumpsters for trash
