WHAT DO THE RECYCLING BINS MEAN?

RECYCLING: Any plastic marked #1-7, glass, plastic and metal drink containers, plastic food containers, juice and milk containers, clean paper.

COMPOST: Napkins, boxes, utensils, econtainers, greenware cups, and food waste.

TRASH: Styrofoam, paper towels, plastic bags, non-compostable utensils, chip bags, plastic coated paper such as coffee cups.

STARBUCKS CUPS are NOT recyclable due to their plastic inner lining. Pick up a reusable mug and receive a 10 cent discount each time you go!

RECYCLING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS



Dumpsters are located outside of every residence hall. **GREEN** is for single stream recycling and **GREY** is for landfill. Try to keep recyclables loose in the container or use a clear trash bag, while trash should be put into black trash bags.

Try to keep recyclables clean. Plastic bottles should be fully empty and paper products free of food residue before recycling!
