## **Impact on Teacher Preparation**

- Attend faculty meetings- From the start at Solley, interns are involved in all aspects of the school. They attend weekly faculty meetings and professional development.
- Participate in collaborative planning Interns participate in weekly collaborative planning meetings. As the internship progresses, interns feel comfortable to share their ideas and insights about the students and curriculum.
- Attend county wide PD Interns are included in all school and system level professional development. They are also invited to attend AACPS PDS Networking Events that cover a range of relevant topics.
- Co-teaching- Mentors and interns use a variety of coteaching models in their classrooms. Co-planning occurs throughout the internship experience.
- Learning Walks Interns, mentors, and other school faculty participate in focused learning walks throughout the building. The focus aligns school goals and the needs of the interns.
- Strategic Planning and Steering Committee Meetings – Mentors, Site Coordinator, Administration and PDS Faculty meet throughout the year to monitor the progress of our Strategic Plan.
- **Reflective Inquiry** Interns collaborate with their mentors to align their project with the School Improvement Plan.
- **Communication with stakeholders** We have established open and direct communication among interns, mentors, site coordinator, administration, and PDS Faculty.
- Mentor Meetings We meet regularly to discuss intern performance, internship expectations, and other ways to support our interns.
