Lisa received a stipend from the ORSP's new program, Funds to Promote Grants Excellence, which seeks to support activities that will strengthen the Loyola faculty's grant expertise. Here's what Lisa had to say about the experience: "It was a lot of work, but it was very helpful, particularly since the DoE program is one that the department has been considering for some time. It helped to clarify exactly what needs to be in place before we submit an application. In fact, I found out that we need to have more in place before we're ready to apply."

That's exactly the purpose behind the Funds to Promote Grants Excellence initiative; to give faculty members insight into what will make for a successful proposal. 
