Supporting the Dyslexic Child in Montessori *with Alison Awes*

Dyslexic children need sequential, multi-sensory and explicit experience with the sounds and symbols of our language to read fluently. The richly prepared environment provides a plethora of language experiences for the primary and elementary aged child. This workshop will cover characteristics of dyslexia, recommendations of the National Reading Panel, and how to support the dyslexic child in a Children's House and then through Cosmic Education.



Alison holds AMI diplomas for Primary and Elementary levels, a B.A. in Art History, a M.A. in Latin American Studies, and a M.Ed. in Montessori Education. She has taught in 6-9 and 9-12 classrooms, and has also presented local and national teacher workshops on bookmaking and handiwork for the elementary child. She is currently Director of Elementary training at the Montessori Training Center of Minnesota.

Establishing Freedoms and Limits *with Jennifer Shields*

The role of the assistant is essential to the implementation of Montessori theory into practice in the Casa dei bambini. This workshop will help assistants understand the nature of the young child, and how to set appropriate limits and to implement freedoms. Topics will include how to observe, when and how to intervene, and how to support the child's work in the environment.

Jennifer holds AMI diplomas at the Primary and Assistants to Infancy levels, as well as a B.A. in English and a M.Ed. in Montessori Education. She has taught for many years in Primary classes and been a frequent workshop presenter. She is currently an AMI Primary trainer at WMI.
